### How and when did you start the website?

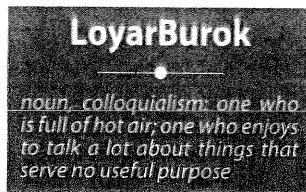

### Any regrets?

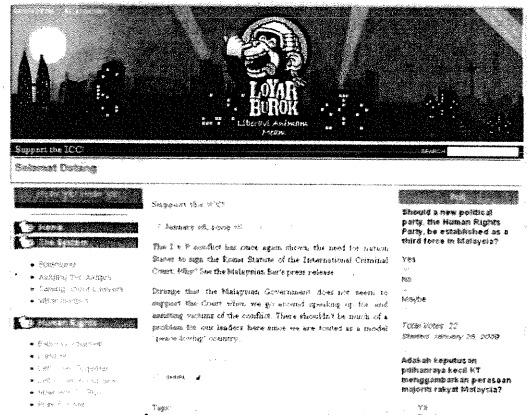
Yes. The quality of pornography on the Internet is dismal, especially on the free sites.
